The achievements and shortcomings of the measures aimed at educating young people in the spirit of military patriotism are also listed.
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Along with pursuing a policy of peace, the Republic of Uzbekistan is committed to ensuring the security, peace and stability of its citizens. Under the United Nations Charter, the state exercises an inviolable right to defense, providing the state with military and defense power at the level of mental adequacy.

Preparing young people to serve in the Armed Forces of the Republic of Uzbekistan is a national task. In order to solve this problem, pre-service basic training, including training in civil defense, is a mandatory subject in the curriculum, and is taught in general education institutions, secondary special and secondary vocational education. Article 13 of the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On General Military Obligation and Military Service" stipulates that pre-service teacher must begin courses or classes on the eve of the year of graduation. Given the importance of these issues, the direction of "Pre-conscription military education" in higher education, that is, one of the main disciplines in the training of future teachers "Pre-conscription" "Military patriotic education".

The main tasks of the discipline "Military patriotic education" are: First, in connection with other disciplines taught in educational institutions, to educate students in the spirit of national patriotism to be always ready to take up arms in defense of their homeland; Second, to develop pedagogical qualities in students, to cultivate active, conscious builders of a new society, people who are loyal to the ideas of national independence, hardworking, courageous and give their lives for their country; Third, to equip students with theoretical and practical knowledge on the issues of "Military patriotic education", to teach them in a position typical of a teacher of "Primary Preparation for Conscription" in secondary schools, lyceums, colleges. -formation of skills and abilities in the organization and conduct of educational work².

Military patriotic education As a result of studying the subject of basic military training, students should know the following: methods of organizing and conducting extracurricular activities, forms and methods, defense and sports activities during the "Primary training of young people before the call" in secondary special and vocational education institutions, organization and holding of "Vatanparvar", "Salomatlik" norms and "Shunkorlar" military sports game, trainings, completion of the subject "Primary training of youth before conscription" to spend processed holidays.

As a result of studying the subject "Military patriotic education" students should be able to: planning and implementation of activities on military patriotic education of students in secondary special educational institutions, ie the organization of trips to places where our people are famous for war and labor, meetings with war and labor veterans, meetings with members of the Armed Forces, conducting theoretical conferences on military patriotism, selection and preparation of candidates for study at military universities, establishment of military circles to learn the basics of military work.

In the process of studying this subject, each student must independently prepare 4-5 lectures (reports, abstracts) on the topic of military patriotism.

Military patriotic education - how to achieve the effectiveness of youth education. The successful solution of the problems of strengthening the defense of our country is closely linked with the education of young people, political consciousness, labor activity and the pace of scientific and technological development. Upbringing is an objectively based process of directing people to physical and mental work or other useful activities for society, as well as preparing them to perform multifaceted social tasks. Military patriotic education is an integral part of it.

Theoretical and practical bases of military patriotic education include the Constitution of Uzbekistan, the ideas of the first President of the Republic of Uzbekistan on patriotism and defense of the independent homeland, laws and resolutions of the Oliy Majlis, the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Special Education, the Ministry of Public Education, There are orders and instructions of the Ministry of Defense, military pedagogy and psychology, military sciences and other rules and regulations. The main document on national defense is reflected in the Law "On Defense". This Law establishes the legal framework for the organization of defense and the management of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Uzbekistan, defines the powers of state bodies in ensuring the country's defense, as well as the participation of citizens' self-government bodies, enterprises, institutions, organizations and citizens.

The Law on Defense has the character of a separate national defense, and prepares the Armed Forces for the elimination and return of aggression, forming a system of ideas that is important for the defense of the Motherland. As long as there are potential sources of military threat, Uzbekistan needs to strengthen its national defense capabilities to the required level.

The guarantee of the peaceful life of the people and the security of the country is the historical task of our Armed Forces, which protects the independence of the young country, which is on the path of independent development and renewal of social relations. Article 52 of the Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan states: It is the duty of every citizen of Uzbekistan to protect the Republic of Uzbekistan. Therefore, the Military Doctrine, approved by the Oliy Majlis on August 30, 1995, defines the main directions of the economy, the region and the preparation of the population for defense.

Preparation of citizens for the defense of the Motherland is carried out in all forms of education. Educators' knowledge of psychology helps them to successfully address the issues of career choice and preparation of high school students for admission to military schools and service in various activities and the Armed Forces of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Military patriotic education of young people is a military science that reveals the nature of modern warfare, the means and forms of armed struggle, its legitimacy, the conditions of hostilities, and is organized taking into account the rules and conclusions. Military science answers questions about what spiritual, political, psychological and combat qualities everyone has, what knowledge and skills they need to successfully fulfill the duties of a defender of the Fatherland.

The scientific basis of military patriotic education is applied and defined in the principles that define the content, organization, form and methods of practical activities for the spiritual, political and physical preparation of young people for the defense of the Fatherland. It develops physical endurance, the ability to cope with heavy physical tasks in daily military service and in combat. Physical education is not just about self-discipline and optimism but also a readiness for labor and defense of the Motherland, a form of productive use of free time.

The school years are the foundation of a lifetime of health. Exercise, gymnastics, sports form the positive qualities of young people. It nurtures feelings such as courage, willpower, and the ability to overcome difficulties. Deficiencies in physical education in childhood are a complex and sometimes completely irreversible process in adulthood. The physical fitness of modern youth does not fully meet the requirements of modern production and service in the Armed Forces.
