If the ideas are fair and just and meet the needs of the majority, the intended goal will be achieved if the educational tools in this area are effective and the educators are active and dedicated. Society is more susceptible to the influence of alien and harmful ideas when people have not yet realized their interests, have not formed their own ideology and are not mobilized for a goal. This makes the task of ideological education, the constant introduction of the principles of a healthy ideology into the consciousness and hearts of the population, urgent.

In fact, an important aspect of personality development is ideological education. This is a process of purposeful formation of philosophical, political, legal, religious, aesthetic, moral, artistic, professional views on life in the system of human consciousness and concepts. After all, any educational process is ideological education in its purpose and essence. Article 58 guarantees the observance of the rights and legitimate interests of public associations and the creation of equal legal opportunities for their participation in public life.

These articles of the Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan created a legal basis for the free development of ideas, the objective expression of various ideas and worldviews, the subjective existence of various classes and strata. The struggle between different ideologies was natural, and it laid the constitutional foundation for which an idea could only be won if it was reasonable, useful, and could indicate the best way forward. Ideological education is one of the important ways to protect our people from external spiritual threats that are rapidly entering our national life under the influence of globalization. Even when there is ideological education, there must be ideological education based on national education. It also requires education in a new content and form, taking into account modern conditions and the possibilities of globalization.
