These games form children's positive moral qualities, such as will, discipline and the ability to control their own behavior, to consider the actions of others. At the same time, the child develops his perception. A child playing a role in a stage play understands and assimilates the positive and negative characteristics of his character. In staging games, children get involved in the game process, they clearly demonstrate positive qualities such as heroism, bravery, kindness, enthusiasm, enthusiasm, which are directly related to the inner life of the heroes of the story and fairy tales. In this process, children's perception of reality and formation of concepts, speech activity, vocabulary, and worldview expand. Perception of space is the process of knowing the place, shape, quantity and relationship of objects and events in reality. This type of perception begins to form in children towards the end of preschool age.

Construction games require the child to describe the image of the object in spatial terms. In the course of the game, the skill of finding the size, size and compatibility of any material or item, and the skill of spatial planning is developed. Children's favorite pastime is playing with sand. Sand is the funnest plaything for children. Sands are kept moist in special boxes. Flags and toys should be prepared and burned for children to play with sand. Sand games, like other games, ensure comprehensive development of children. In particular, it has the property of calming the child's psychology, develops hand motor skills, enriches creative imagination and imagination, and forms creativity. Water games are also one of the child's favorite games. Almost all children start playing with water from an early age. Water also has the property of calming the child. Washing, cleanliness is not only a hygienic requirement, but also teaches understanding of cleanliness, its correct use, environment and nature. Understanding and understanding things like bathing a doll in water and playing with toys in water are important for a child's development.
