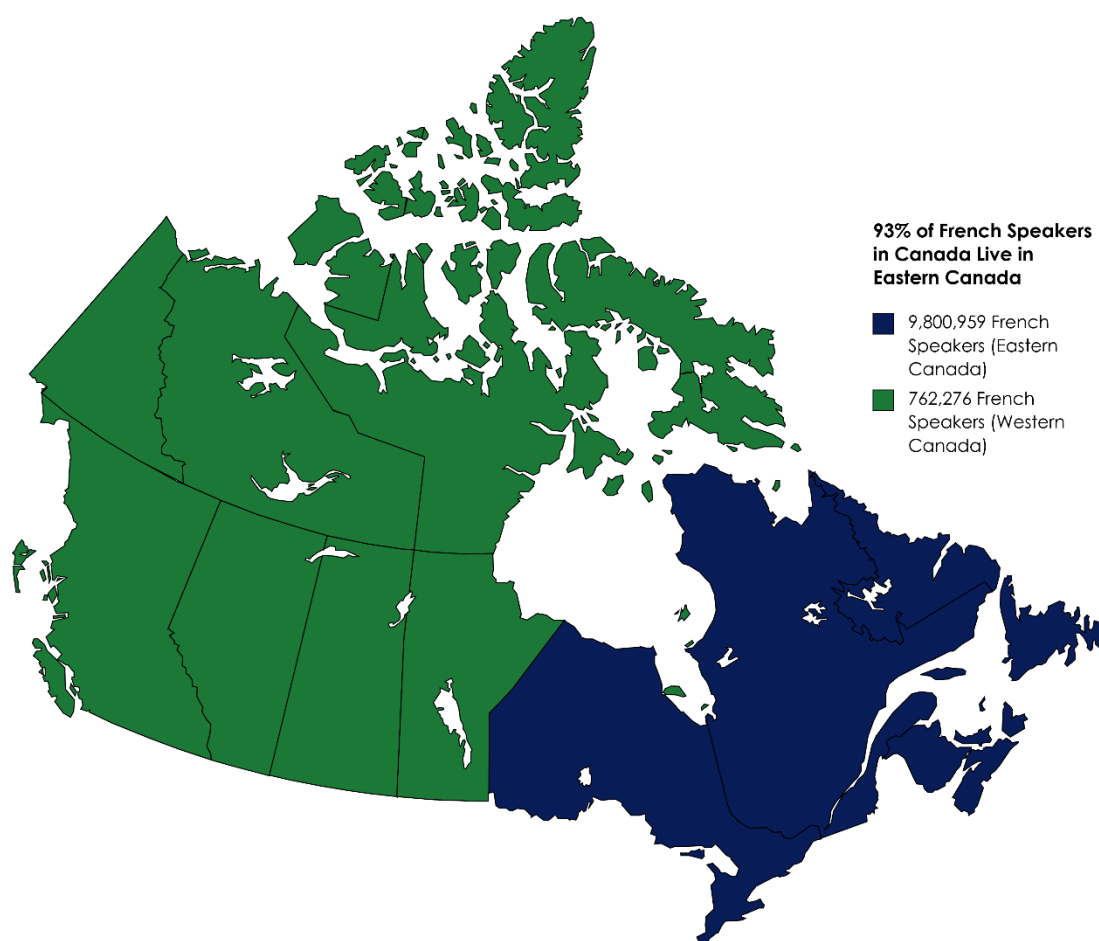

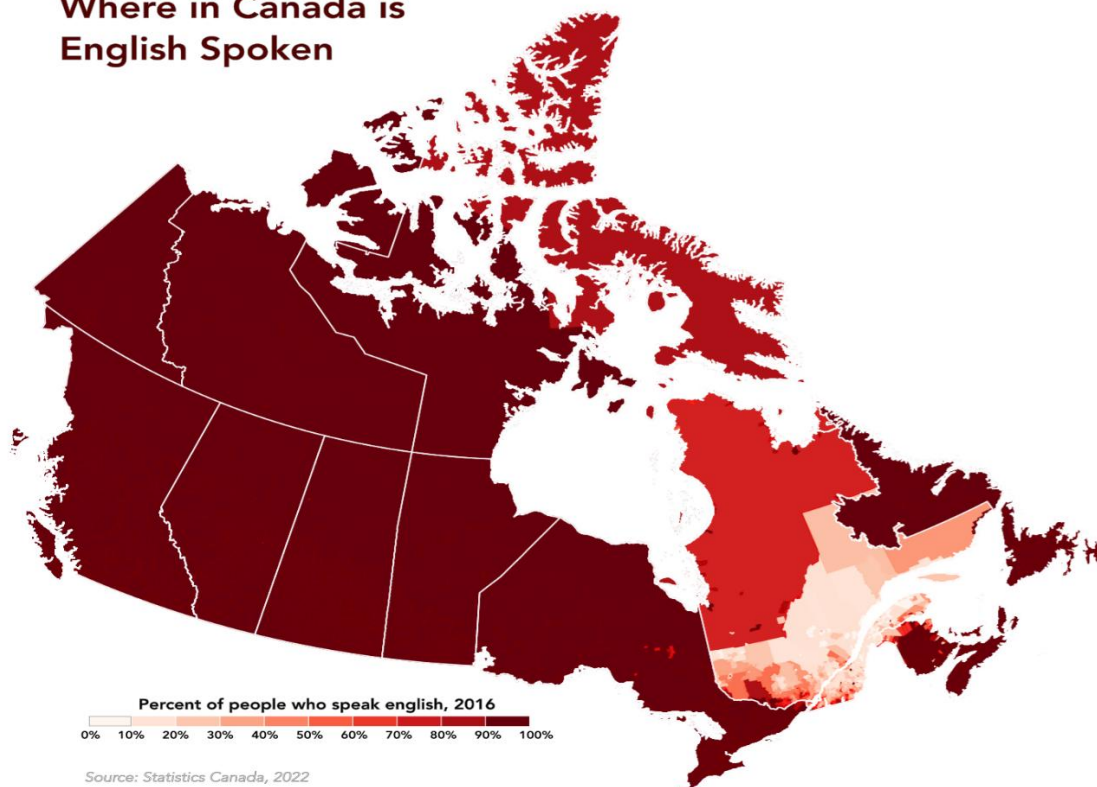


Parliament's Hill located in the capital city of Canada, Peace-Tower

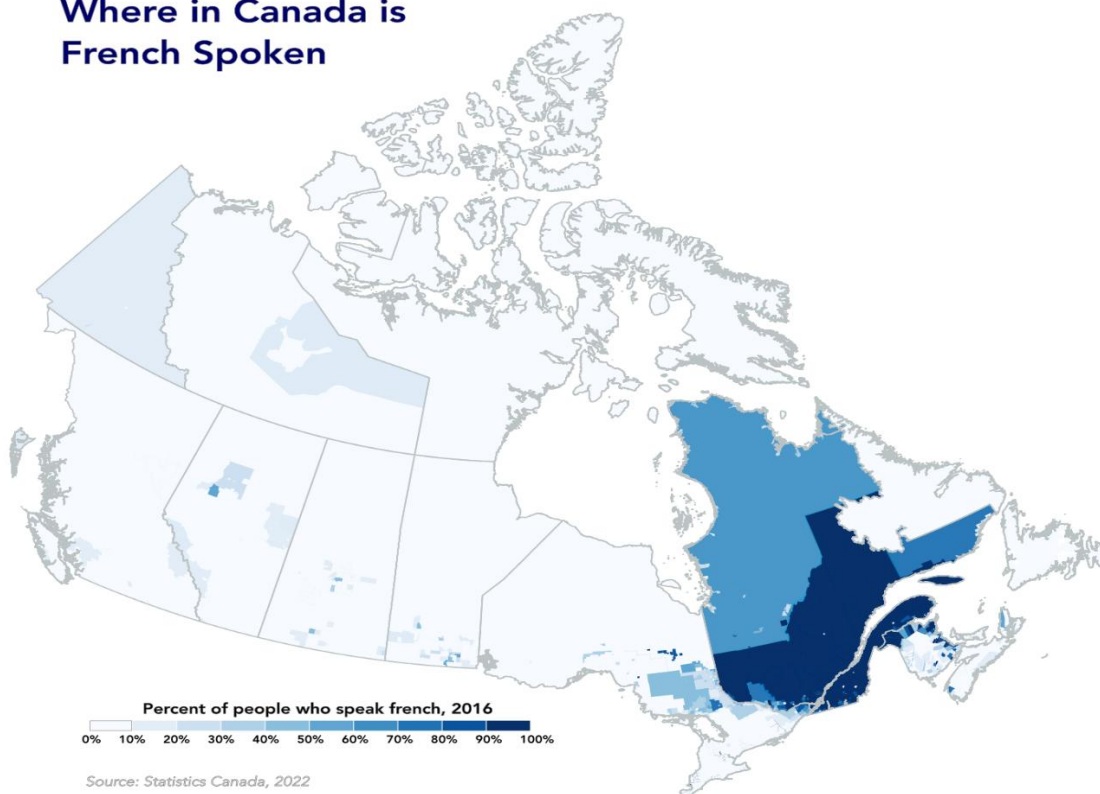
