A) The first step is to create a background on a well-stretched canvas: choose a color that we will use as the depth of the work. The wallpaper is mostly dark (black or blue)

It is also possible to create a background in light colors, however in this case we cannot get depth.

The second stage is a very interesting part, but in the second stage, the artist will have to wait a while before moving, because the resulting wallpaper must be dried to start styling, so our geometric shapes need an oil

palette. To produce a color-lasting color, remember that oil is the most transparent colorant needed to produce oil when creating an oil painting.

The second stage is a very aesthetic painstaking work, we select colors and carry out finishing work, holding the canvas with miniature geometric shapes at a short distance.

Geometric figures are in the form of cubes or triangles, the artist chooses the forms according to his taste and imagination. The distance between the cubes must be respected because the wallpaper is visible (distance 1 cm).

And this makes the drawing more interesting.

When paving, we change the color palette to give the work a monumental look.
