



## **INNOVATIONS IN PRIMARY EDUCATIONAL METHODOLOGY**

If the child is struggling with the last topics in the lesson, it will be easier for the teacher to notice and find out which student is having a hard time mastering the lesson and which student is having a stronger mastery than the rest.

Another advantage of not being given homework is that the teacher and the student spend more time together and the teacher spends more time with the children. We know that if homework is given first, it will take time for the teacher to check the tasks and it will be more difficult to explain the topic to the children in a complete and complete way. Now such difficulties are being overcome. In the Mother Tongue and Reading Literacy textbook, each section has its own name and the topics in this section are different.

For example, there are interesting sections on the blessings of nature, a healthy mind, language science and technology. Each section covers a specific topic. "Healthy Mind" section talks about vegetables, fruits, how to cook from them, white poplar, blue poplar, chess, lanka games, as well as adding, separating words in the given mantras. The difference between the letter combinations "x" and "h", the difference between the syllables, the spelling of the letter q in some words, the use of the suffixes "-li, -siz, -roq" are discussed together. Interesting texts, poems and assignments on these topics are reflected in the book.

If we turn our attention to another section of the textbook, "Science and Technology", it is interesting that there are interesting texts about the planets, the universe, the earth, facts, experiments on the human body, travel words and of course, the flu is about interesting mantles.

Analyzed in the native language, it consists of the order in which the famous names are written, the similarity of the words, the use of foreign words now in our country and assignments on many texts. Each topic in the textbook is appropriate for the child's age, worldview, reasoning, thinking.

In addition, difficult-to-understand words in the topics are clearly indicated at the end of the textbook. In our country, it is in the hands of our educators to bring up and educate educated, sharp-minded, well-rounded young people.

Every educator is worthy of the name of a true educator only if he works diligently, researches, contributes to the development of education, loves his profession and truly expresses his love for his profession.

It is the responsibility of the younger generation to constantly open new opportunities in our society, to make our country one of the developing countries.
